ACTION MEMO

The basic theme should be gotten out of our fear of an all out liberal media support for McGovern. Our concern is that this will be even more intensive than the liberal media support for Humphrey in 1968 as was pointed out in the Efron book.

We, therefore, are forgetting about our position in the polls because we look at what the media did to Nixon and for Humphrey last time around, and recognize that it can, and undoubtedly will, be done again this time.
