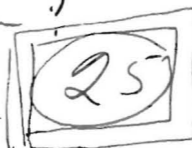

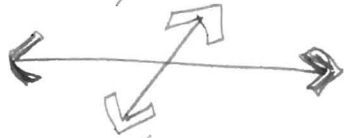

Tricia Nixon will marry Edward Ridley Finch Cox before about 400 seated guests in the White House Rose Garden at 4 p.m. June 12, Connie Stuart, Mrs. Nixon's staff director announced yesterday.

Miss Nixon will be the first bride to be married on the White House grounds.

The altar will probably be set up at the west end of the rose garden, with a string group playing on the bricked patio at the east end. Guests will enter through the east gate, go through the orangerie and into the garden.

The wedding party will come down the south staircase and the driveway and into the garden. After the ceremony they'll return the same way to have pictures taken in the Grand Hall.

Guests will be received by the wedding party in the Blue Room and then go on to refreshments in the State dining room, cake cutting in the Grand Hall and dancing to Bill Harrington's orchestra in the East Room.

Harrington played for the wedding receptions of Julie Nixon and David Eisenhower, Barbara Ann Eisen-

hower and Fernando Echeverria-Urbe, and for the 1969 inaugural ball at the Statler Hilton. His orchestra will have 10 members for the Cox reception.

Mrs. Stuart said plans for the ceremony itself are not yet complete, though the Rev. Dr. Edward Gardiner Latch, the chaplain of the House of Representatives, will be the presiding minister.

Invitations to family and friends will go out about four weeks ahead. Mrs. Stuart said that, of course, with two months yet to go, all plans are subject to change.

If it rains on the day of the wedding, the ceremony may be moved in to the East Room. No tents have been ordered.

The prospective bride and

groom have not yet announced members of their wedding party. But Julie Nixon Eisenhower will likely be her sister's matron of honor and Howard Ellis Cox Jr. his brother's best man.

Mrs. Stuart said the networks already have requested permission to televise the ceremony. "We are considering offering portions of the wedding for TV coverage," she said. "We're considering everything. We're hoping to be as cooperative as possible."

# Tongues Wag Over Guest List

The romantic glow of President and Mrs. Nixon's engagement party for daughter Tricia was peppered with politics.

The guest list of 300, billed as a group of family friends and Irish types, set tongues wagging throughout official Washington.

Congressional Democrats outnumbered Republicans among the invited guests.

No blacks attended, not even Mayor Walter Washington, who provides window dressing at some Republican functions.

Rep. Robert McClory, R-Ill., whipped out a news release, hoping to make political hay from the fact that he was "among the handful of congressional guests."

Some old Nixon friends—like top aides John Ehrlichman and H. R. Haldeman and Nixon's 1968 pre-convention manager, Sen. Henry Bellmon of Oklahoma—were passed over in favor of casual acquaintances like movie actor Fred MacMurray and Irene Ryan ("Granny") of the Beverly Hillbillies.

"I don't know why I'm here," the suntanned MacMurray said in the flower-bedecked White House foyer. He wondered if his invitation stemmed from a brief encounter with Nixon in 1969.

"Bob Hope called Jimmy Stewart and me that day," MacMurray recalled. "He said the President was flying up from San Clemente and they needed a couple of Republicans he could beat at golf."

## Fat Cats

Besides the young friends of Tricia and her fiance, Edward Finch Cox, the list included such Republican fat cats as Hobart Lewis of the Reader's Digest, New York Banker George Champion, and multimillionaire aerosol king Robert Abplanalp.

Abplanalp said his luxurious home on the island of Grand Cay in the Bahamas would be available to Tricia and Ed for their honeymoon, if they wanted it.

The invitation list was understood to have been worked out by the elder Nixons, Tricia, Ed, and the President's strong right arm, Rose Mary Woods.

Admittedly, it must have been difficult to hold

down a list for a party designed to serve four purposes:

An official reception for visiting Irish Prime Minister John Lynch; a celebration marking First Lady Pat Nixon's 59th birthday; the buttering-up of a few key congressmen; and the anticlimactic announcement of an engagement which had been publicized for months.

With the exception of Wisconsin Rep. John W. Byrnes, most of the politicians who came were not family friends. Byrnes has political value as the ranking Republican on the tax-writing Ways and Means Committee.

The closest thing to a Republican Senator at the party was conservative James Buckley of New York, who is not a personal friend of the Nixons or Coxes. Buckley is Irish, however, and is being wooed politically by the GOP.

Three Democratic senators whose names begin with "Mc" were invited, ostensibly because of their Irish heritage. Two are keys to Nixon's political success on Capital Hill.

## Supporters

Government operations chairman John McClellan of Arkansas may be Nixon's main hope for passing his reorganization plan. Wyoming's Gale McGee, the only democratic "hawk" on the Senate Foreign Relations Committee, said he takes flak from some colleagues for supporting the President on Vietnam. His reward lies in occasional White House invitations.

One of the most surprising bids went to Sen. Thomas McIntyre, liberal, dovish New Hampshire Democrat. When Mrs. McIntyre's bout with virus caused the couple to miss the glittering event, they were crushed.

Two powerful democratic House committee chairmen whose Irish ties are somewhat obscure seemed to enjoy the flattering attentions. They were George Mahon of Appropriations and Thomas Morgan of Foreign Affairs.

"George said lots of people would have liked to have been there last night," Mrs. Mahon said. "It was one of the loveliest things we have ever been to at the White House."
